The FFCCHA Quarterly State Meetings were held the weekend of November 2-4, 2012 in Ocala, FL at the College of Central Florida campus. We welcomed 8 first time attendees and four guests. Peter Smith and Lisa Olds from ABCMouse gave a presentation on their learning program being offered to members and as a fundraiser for FFCCHA. Jeff Kostiha, from A-Plus Insurance, gave a presentation explaining the current insurance coverage for FFCCHA and the Chapters. Roseann Fricks, Executive Director, Marion County Early Learning Coalition, gave an update and explanation on ELIS (Early Learning Information System).

Three appointments by the President, Lynn Gibson, were approved by the Full Board to fill vacant positions. 

## Relationships: The Heart of Development and Learning

All learning takes place in the context of relationships and is critically affected by the quality of those relationships. Many research studies have identified that learning is based in relationships. Emotional development is critical in infant development and requires a strong emphasis on relationships in an appropriate and effective curriculum. Strong relationships with adults help infants respond to the wide range of emotions that emerge during infancy. Experts have stated that "the primary need of infants and toddlers is emotional connection. Relationships are the key and emotional development is the critical domain." (Lloyd-Jones)

#### Question: How are relationships different than interactions?

Answer: I had the opportunity to attend a national conference in which a speaker made this statement. This was one of those "AH-HA" moments for me. If you think about your daily life you have hundreds of interactions throughout the day with many different people but at the end of the day, did you really have a relationship with most of those people? Interactions can be your response to a comment, gesture, or action and may only be one-sided or maybe mutual. The interaction may last one second or for an extended period of time. Relationships, on the other hand, are built over time and have a "give and take" aspect. Relationships are established connections between two people and are reciprocal in that both you and the other person benefit from the interactions that support the relationship. ### **Background Screening Update**

There have been many changes in the Background Screening requirements over the past two years. As we look forward to 2013, we are preparing to move to a new and exciting phase in Background Screening.

This past legislative session brought about the creation of the Care Provider Background Screening Clearinghouse. The Clearinghouse will enhance the services the Department currently offers providers. The Clearinghouse will allow select social service agencies to share criminal history information, thus eliminating duplicate screenings for each agency. Each agency will continue to process screening results for the providers it licenses or regulates. It will allow for the retention of fingerprints providing immediate notification if an employee is arrested for a criminal offense in Florida. Additionally, Live Scan providers will be required to submit a photograph at the time fingerprints are submitted to the Florida Department of Law Enforcement. The Agency for Health Care Administration is charged with the development of the Clearinghouse and plans to begin implementation January 1, 2013. The agencies involved will be phased in over the next year.

As the Department moves toward implementation, information will be provided to ensure a smooth transition.

#### **NAFCC Observer Qualifications**

#### An Observer must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Be an individual member of NAFCC
- 2. Be at least 21 years of age
- 3. Be NAFCC Accredited (if a family child care provider) OR work closely with FCC (see # 6)
- 4. Successfully complete required training
- 5. Successfully complete reliable observations once assigned
- 6. Meet all of the requirements in <u>one</u> of the four combinations of education and experience outlined below:
  - A. **Six semester hours** of study from an accredited college or university covering children ages birth through school-age. At least **eight years experience** working as a family child care provider **or** someone who has worked closely with family child care.
  - B. **Twelve semester hours** of study from an accredited college or university covering children ages birth through age five. At least **six years experience** working as a family child care provider **or** someone who has worked closely with family child care.
  - C. Associate (two-year) degree in early childhood education/child development or a related field from an accredited college or university. Courses must include at least 12 semester hours covering children ages birth through age five. At least four years experience working as a family child care provider or someone who has worked closely with family child care.
  - D. **Baccalaureate degree** in early childhood education/child development or a related field from an accredited college or university. Courses must include at least 12 semester hours covering children ages birth through age five. At least **two years experience** working as a family child care provider **or** someone who has worked closely with family child care.

#### **Bilingual Observer Qualifications**

In addition to meeting observer qualifications, bilingual observers must meet the following:

- 1. Be able to speak, read, and write Spanish and English well enough to understand and be understood by both children and adults.
- 2. Have one year direct experience with bilingual early childhood programs and with non-English-speaking populations

## Chapter News—Chapter Spotlight

Debbie Pintar, FFCCHA Chapter Coordinator



The Chapter News articles will have a different focus now. I will be reporting on Chapter Reps about their Area, Chapter, and members. I hope you enjoy reading and learning about the FFCCHA Chapters around the state. This quarter, I interviewed the 2011 FFCCHA Chapter Rep of the Year, Robin Vasil, and President of local Chapter: Pinellas Providers Home Child Care Association (PPHCCA).

PPHCCA is located in Pinellas County (FFCCHA Area #22). They are one of three FFCCHA Chapters available to serve the 477 licensed family child care providers in Pinellas. Pinellas County has seen some changes

recently regarding licensing ratios and their Resource and Referral line is now handled through Tampa Bay Cares 211. Pinellas Providers Chapter serves the Mid-Pinellas County area, with membership of 61, and about half attending monthly meetings. They meet every fourth Monday of the month at the Pinellas Park City Auditorium located at 7690 59th Street N. in Pinellas Park with the exception of August and December. They offer in-service training hours on pertinent topics such as Making SENSE of Sensory Integration and Modulation Issues in Children and the DIR Model (Developmental, Individual differences, Relationship-based). Although Pinellas Providers Chapter does not have a website or Facebook page, they keep in touch with their members though mass e-mails, monthly training reminder postcards, and Dialmycalls.com. The chapter also serves their community with donation drives for the Pinellas Hope Homeless Community and 20 Angels for Foster Angel Tree. They feel the rewards are theirs and not just the people they have helped. If you live in the area or just visiting, they would love to have you come to their next meeting.
