

Chapter News

While at the August Quarterly Meeting in Ocala, I had several providers ask me what information each member of a chapter should be given yearly from their local chapter and how long can each board member serve in a position. Below are the answers.

What information should be given to every chapter member yearly from their Local FFCCHA chapter?

- Each chapter has the Fiscal Year of: June 1 May 31 (Chapter By-laws, Article: XII).
- After May 31 of the current year, there is to be an audit of the books by a committee of at least 3 members appointed by the Executive Board. (Article XII, Section 7)
- A budget committee appointed by the Executive Board must prepare and submit a balanced chapter budget to be approved by the chapter members. (Article XII, Section 7)
- A schedule of chapter meetings (minimum of 4 meetings each year) and training needs to be approved by the chapter members. (Article VIII)
- A list of the approved board members, their positions held and their contact information.

How long does each local chapter board member serve in each position?

- Each position on the board is voted in every 2 years. There is a two term limit for each position. (Article VI, Section 6.2)
- A Nominating Committee of at least 3 members shall be elected by chapter at least 2 months prior to elections. This committee is responsible to nominate eligible candidates for each position. (Article VI, Section 6.3)
